Getting Started: Register for our Website:

Welcome to Lansdowne on the Potomac! Our website is the source of truth for all Lansdowne on the Potomac (LOTP) information, key documents, events, clubs, amenities, and information.

To begin please go to www.lansdownehoa.com and register.

- On the lansdownehoa.com homepage, go to the link on the right side of the screen that says "Register".
 - Once on the registration page, you will have two options: Renter or Homeowner. Please select the appropriate option
 - Next, the website will ask for your information. Enter your first and last name, best email address and phone # for the HOA to contact you, a password you'll remember, and your new LOTP address. You will also be asked if you would like to receive community emails as well as be included in the resident directory
 - If the association has your ALTA papers and can confirm your residency you will be admitted to the members only section of the website within one week. If the Association has not yet received your conveyance information, they may contact you directly to confirm.

Get Your LOTP Membership Cards:

Your LOTP Membership Card is your key to use the amenities at the Potomac Club. After checking in, you will have access to our amenities and guest passes. Card privileges are based on age, and include:

- Red cards for ages 7-11
- Yellow cards for ages 12-15
- Blue cards for ages 16+

To get your membership cards:

- Sign in to your www.lansdownehoa.com account and go to the Resident Hub and click on Pool and Fitness Center
- Click Pool and Fitness Center Application
- Fill out the requested information and upload a headshot of each registrant. Headshots should be an unobstructed view of the resident. We request that the photo does not include sunglasses.
- To add additional family members to an existing account, please use the button underneath the Pool and Fitness Card Application that says, "**To add members to an existing membership account, click [here.](#)**"
- For an expedited process, please attach your closing documents or ALTA in the appropriate field.
- Membership cards will be ready within five days of submission.
- Mobile Flash Passes (Digital membership cards that can be added to a digital wallet) are sent out after new registrations and are also available to be sent in general, upon request. In addition to your physical membership card, you can use a photo of your card for entry to the facilities. Start Using Your New Community Amenities!

Our clubhouse amenities are open Monday - Friday, 6 a.m. - 9 p.m., and Saturday - Sunday 9 a.m. - 8 p.m.; our outdoor pools are open (Summer only) 10 a.m. - 8 p.m. Memorial Day through Labor Day weekends. The Potomac Club is closed for some holidays and hours may be modified for emergencies or for weather conditions. Please check our website, Facebook Page, and the Friday Flash for updates.

Our amenities include:

- The (indoor + outdoor) Potomac Club pools and (outdoor) Coton Club pool
- Sand volleyball court (Potomac Club)
- Fully equipped fitness center
- Rentable and reservable event spaces in the Potomac Club: Gardner Ballroom (fees apply), Lower Lounge (first come first serve, optional fees apply), Gathering Room (fees apply), or Conference Room (first come first serve, available upon reservation, no fees)
- Potomac Club game room (featuring pool, ping pong, foosball, air hockey, Skee ball, and other games)
- Potomac Club business center with computer; ability to print
- Three recently renovated tennis courts (two painted with pickleball lines)
- Five tot lots (three completely upgraded and renovated in April 2022)
- Amphitheater (behind Potomac Club) with events and concerts
- HOA sponsored events, activities, and clubs for LOTP HOA residents

Lansdowne's location along the Potomac River offers water lovers and outdoor enthusiasts a place to fish, hike, canoe, and kayak. Access is available at the Elizabeth Mills Riverfront Park and the Kephart Bridge Landing which is located just off Riverpoint Drive in Lansdowne. Residents can also access the Potomac Heritage Scenic Trail. Your TV, Intranet TV, and internet service are included as part of your monthly HOA contribution. Comcast/Xfinity provides services to our neighborhood and includes the Standard TV with 125+ channels, High Definition and X1, as well as internet service with symmetrical speeds of up to 600Mbps/600Mbps. The package includes video service in one outlet per home. Residents can add TV boxes and services for an additional fee. The internet service includes a state-of-the-art router capable of delivering wired or wireless internet service throughout your home. Through the master plan process, we are enhancing the resident experience for those who live in Lansdowne, creating an attractive and relevant community for future residents, and protecting property values. The master plan is a community effort guided by a resident-run committee of our Board of Directors who seek resident participation and feedback through numerous informational presentations, town hall meetings, a community-wide survey, and focus groups. Lansdowne is currently implementing key master plan improvements, including improvements to our main waterfall and ponds, upgrading our playgrounds, modernizing the interior of the resident-only Potomac Club, adding a 3,649 square foot fitness center, and providing additional safety and security updates.
